How to ZIP Files & Folders

<u>Why We Zip</u>

Zipping (i.e. compressing) files and folders significantly reduces the size of the files and folders. This allows more data to be transferred via email (or other method).

<u>How To Zip</u>

1. Navigate to the files/folders in Windows Explorer. To open Windows Explorer either double-click My Computer and choose the drive (usually your C drive), or right-click the Start button and click Explore.



- 2. Select all the files & folders to be zipped using your left mouse button.
 - a. You can hold Ctrl to select multiple files at once.
 - b. You can also click the first file, then hold Shift, and click the last file to select every file in between them.



 Right click any of the already selected files/folders and choose Send To > Compress Folder.

The system will create a single zip file which has all the selected files & folders stored within it. This zip file can then be emailed, uploaded via the Frazier Online Vault, or otherwise used as needed.
